## Marcelpoil



Specialising in Art Deco furniture and objects, the gallery presents the work of influential artists like André Sornay, Robert Mallet-Stevens, Ivan Da Silva Bruhns and Claudius Linossier. Galerie Alain Marcelpoil, 15 rue de Miromesnil (8th),

Noirmont

A contemporary gallery opened in 1994 by Jérôme and Emmanuelle de Noirmont with the purpose of introducing virtually unknown French and foreign artists to the French public. Though their roster is now full of internationally acclaimed artists like, Scott David Mach, A.R. Specialising in Asian Art, the gallery proposes Vietnamese masterpieces from Champa, rare bronzes from Dong So'n, statues of Buddha from South East Asia and funeral objects from the Ming dynasty. Galerie Hlolo, 12 rue de Penthievre (8th), 01.53.30.09.65.



Opened in 2002 by Eric Dereumaux and Eric Rodrigue, the Galerie RX represents young French or International artists working with paint or photography and supports them in their professional career.
